Youth Public Organization “New European Generation” (Ukraine) in partnership with Izmail State University of Humanities (Ukraine), Tulcea County Agency for Employment (Romania) and Patronage of Small and Medium Sized Enterprises of Tulcea County (Romania), implements the project “CBC-DEBUS – Innovative Development of Entrepreneurial Education and Stimulation of New Business in Cross-Border Region”, (EMS ENI code - 2SOFT/1.1/128), founded by the European Union through Joint Operational Programme “Romania-Ukraine 2014-2020”.
